December Fundraiser-(1) Christmas basket and (2) Christmas Dinner

Tickets are \$5.00 each. We will either mail or hand-deliver a book of 4 tickets to each member. You can sell them or buy them. The Christmas Basket is usually made up of items donated by members and items purchased by the Lodge. Scott's Independent Store contribute \$50.00 toward a \$100.00 Gift Card, and the Elks pays the other \$50.00.

Raise in dues to be effective January 1, 2025

Our dues are \$70.00 annually for regular members, with a \$10.00 discount if paid before January 1. Family members pay \$120.00 with a \$20.00 discount.

Here is the notice of motion that will be presented at the December Lodge Meeting.

"To increase the membership dues to \$85.00 per member per calendar year; Provided, however, that a member shall be entitled to a discount of \$10.000 from the member dues if paid by December 31 of the preceding year (which will be known as the "due date:).

To remain a member in good standing with the Lodge and with Grand Lodge, a member's dues must be fully paid no later than three months after the due date.

A new member joining the Lodge within a calendar year shall pay membership dues proportionally for the remainder of the calendar year following the new member's initiation.

Further provided, however, that a 20% discount shall be afforded to families as defined by the national bylaws.
